Academic Calendar

The academic year includes:

- start and end dates of lessons
- exam sessions
- graduation periods

Teaching activities are usually arranged within **two semesters** although some courses may both periods (annual).

First semester

Lessons > 1 October 2024 / 18 January 2025

1st Exam session > 20 January / 1 March 2025

Second semester

Lessons > 3 March 2025 / 14 June 2025

2nd Exam session > 16 June / 31 July 2025

Exams and Grades

Examinations are graded according to a scale ranging from 0 to 30, with 18 as a pass mark. A "cum laude" may be added to the highest grade (30; 30 e lode) as a mention of special distinction.

Only if you pass the exam you will obtain the relevant credits (CFU - Crediti Formativi Universitari = ECTS – European Credit Transfer System).

All exams (passed and failed) will be recorded in the Transcript of records issued at the end of your mobility

Some rules & procedures

Change your learning agreement

Students accepted for one semester can make only one change, within 5 weeks after the start of the mobility.

Students accepted for the entire academic year can change their

Learning Agreement twice, one for each semester. Second within March.

Attendance

A minimum 60% rate of classes attendance is required, in order to be admitted to exams. Upon their arrival, students will be provided by the IDU with specific information on classes attendance registrations and exams.

How to register?

- Install the APP EASY CAMPUS on your device
- Peach the **E.R.S.U.** *Catering Services Office* (Catania, Via Etnea n. 570, opening hours Wednesday 15.30 18.00) with the smartphone with the APP, the ID/Passport and the copy of acceptance letter/registration card.
- You will be enabled to put money on your virtual "canteen card" through the APP.
- Book your meal at the canteen, use the APP to pay by passing the smartphone at the TOTEM.


